Language Access Services



48 hour basic medical interpreter training course:

- \$ 725 for registrations received before two weeks of the first class start date (*This fee includes language proficiency assessment, course fees and materials*).
- Students that do not complete tuition fee by the last day of course will be assessed a 5% penalty fee each month amount is late until full amount is paid.
- Late registrations are accepted up to one week prior to class start date but include an additional fee of \$100 (\$725 + \$100= \$825.00).
- ***Organizations*** - Effective **8/1/11** there will be a 5% late fee added on any pending invoices not paid within 30 business days

- 48 hour *Interpreting in Health Care and Community Settings basic training* (for pricing information contact Eastern CT AHEC)
- Bilingual employee language proficiency assessments for English and language of service
 - *Spanish language of service assessment: \$300.00 for up to four employees, pass/fail results for full reports \$ 500 for up to four employees*
 - *There will be a \$25.00 penalty fee for each employee that does not contact us to cancel within 24 hours of their scheduled testing time.*
 - *Other language of service assessment: \$500 for up to four employees, pass/fail results for full report \$ 700 for up to four employees.*
 - ***Organizations*** - Effective **8/1/11** there will be a 5% late fee added each month amount due to Eastern AHEC is not submitted
